There has been a recent increase in measles cases in the Bristol area.

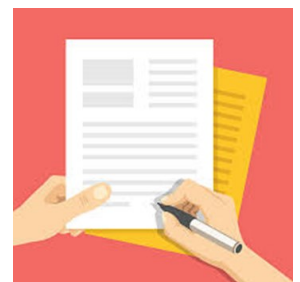
